Abstract

The great sewage treatment plant of Köln-Stammheim currently disposes of a Contronic P automation system, provided by Hartmann & Braun. Due to termination of this product range by June 2008, adoption of a new strategy was necessary. Among others, the process control system was considered as a crucial factor for the entire concept. According to the new design, all automated units, including the process control system, had to be completely renewed. A total of 15,000 external data points had to be integrated into the system. The fibre optic cable was made available to join the sub-centres and connect them to the central control unit.
